The Opening Ceremony of the International Congress on Mobility Management, that will take place next 11 December in Madrid, will be chaired by Luis Aguilera Ruiz, Subsecretary of the Spanish Home Office. Antonio de Guindos, Delegate from the Government Area of Environment, Safety and Mobility, will attend with him the Opening in representation of the City Council of Madrid.

Furthermore, other personalities are invited to the Opening Ceremony: the Director of Traffic from the Spanish Home Office, María Seguí; the Chairman of the Spanish Road Association, Miguel M^º Muñoz; The Delegate Counselor of the Spanish Institute of Foreign Trade (ICEX), M^º del Coriseo González; the Vice-Chairman of the Spanish Association for Standardization and Certification (AENOR), Aniceto Zaragoza; and the Chairman of the Association of Civil Engineers, Juan Santamera. All of them will take part in the Opening Ceremony of this Congress that has the objective of becoming a national and international reference on mobility management in urban and interurban area.

The Congress that will last until the 13 December is led by the Traffic Department of the Spanish Home Office, organized by the Spanish Road Association and promoted by the City Council of Madrid.

During the Congress, there will be simultaneous translation of all the conferences.

Visit to the Center of Automated Complaints – ESTRADA

Fines: from the radar to the offender's pocket, via satellite

Three thousand square meters, about 130 experts and a technological equipment of last generation enable to transform driving offences, seen through the radars located in Spanish roads, in complaints and are automatically processed without any Traffic Cop, arriving directly to the address of the offender. The control of payment is even made automatically.

This work is made from the Center of Automated Complaints (ESTRADA), situated in the city of Leon and promoted by the Spanish Home Office at the end of 2007. The attendees to the International Congress on Mobility Management will be able to visit this Center the last day of the Congress and check *in situ* its operation.
